

**HOWARD TOWNSHIP PARK BOARD MEETING
PROPOSED MINUTES
June 6, 2022**

Present: Debbie Floor, Jan Gordon, Marcia Pedzinski, Erika Pickles

Absent: Don Cross

Gordon called the meeting to order at 6 p.m. and led the pledge of allegiance. Roll call attendance was taken and the proposed minutes of the May regular meeting were presented, Pickles made a motion to accept the minutes, Floor seconds, motion passed.

Treasurer's report: Invoices included electric, Joy Johns, trash, fuel, mower parts and paint and other miscellaneous supplies. Motion made by Pedzinski to accept the report as presented, seconded by Floor, motion passed.

Correspondence: Note received from the Township that donations would be appreciated to replenish the flower fund

Old Business:

- Jones Park pavilion roof: should be completed by the end of this month
- New tractor is in use; some minor issues have been addressed
- Fence repair at Pepper Martin: waiting for materials to complete this
- Playground equipment at Ellis: remains on hold waiting for further contact and in-person preview of condition
- Still waiting for contact from Bangarangatan reps for league disc golf play
- Light poles and wiring at Pepper Martin: new pole was installed; some lights have been donated but need inspected to see if they can be used or if can get replacement bulbs

New Business:

- Note was received from Scott Zavity regarding concerns of the ballfields at Pepper Martin; most of these will be referred to HTBL. Discussion of remaining issues included broken chains in lower parking lot (this has been completed); some vandalism (times of damage has coincided with gates being left open and this has been addressed); extra trash around the fields (suggested a post on social media to remind residents to pick up after themselves, Pickles will take care of this)

Park Supervisor's report: Normal upkeep of parks; issue in bathroom at Pepper Martin was taken care of prior to the holiday weekend; an above-ground fuel tank has been ordered for gasoline so tractors can be taken care of when needed without immediate trip to station

Township Park reports:

Hatcherville/Cross: absent; nothing new

Jones/Gordon: nothing new to report

Kiddie Korral/Pedzinski: nothing new to report

Pepper Martin/Floor: nothing new to report

Sholtey/Pickles: some end of year school programs scheduled at park, Northside this Thursday 6:30-7:30p

Public comments: Gordon reports that the old Township Hall clean-up and repair is completed and rentals are already being scheduled for several weekends

A motion to adjourn was made by Pedzinski, seconded by Floor.
